With the goal of exploring and extending the thriving wiki community, **WikiSym 2010** will once again bring together researchers, practitioners, and consultants to discuss and share knowledge and experience on all areas related to wikis and wiki philosophy, ranging from social to technical, and from theoretical to experience studies.

WikiSym 2010 is an ACM SIGWEB¹ conference and offers a rigorously reviewed research paper track, as well as plenty of space for practitioner reports, discussion of work in progress, demonstrations, tutorials, and informal, but lively, OpenSpace and WikiFest sessions.

This year's conference (the sixth) will take place from 7-9 July 2010, in Gdańsk, Poland, following successful editions in San Diego (2005), Odense (2006), Montreal (2007), Porto (2008) and Orlando (2009). The conference will bring together thought leaders from all over the world.
